1.11 1929-32 A.E.C. Reliance 660

The A.E.C. Reliance was introduced in 1928 and was essentially an updated version of the A.D.C 426, A.D.C being the joint company set up between Daimler and A.E.C. which was in existence for about two years around 1926-28. 484 Reliance 660s were produced between 1928 and 1932, the chassis having a wheelbase of 16ft 0in and an A.E.C. 6-cylinder 6.1 litre petrol engine. The Red & White examples came from the absorbed companies Bassett-Enterprise and Gough's Welsh Motorways.
