New vehicle deliveries were very difficult in 1947 and a number of second hand vehicles were purchased by Red & White including five 1936 Daimler COG5 single deckers with Gardner 5LW oil engines from Birmingham City Transport. They were all rebodied or rebuilt by Welsh Metal Industries before being put into service.
