### 1. Single Deck Buses

#### 1.17 1936 Albion Valkyrie PW69

The Albion Valkyrie PW69s were built in 1935-36. They had a 17ft 9in wheelbase for up to 39 seats. The Red & White examples were classified SpPW69 indicating oil engines and were provided with Gardner 5LW engines. They were the first of many vehicles to be bodied by Duple for Red & White.
