1.31 1957 Bristol SC

The Bristol SC (or "small capacity") lightweight bus was produced between 1954 and 1961 with a conventional front-engined layout and Gardner 4LK 3.8 litre engine. Red & White purchased four in 1957 and acquired three more in 1962 from United Counties. All were painted in the red with white window frame livery.
